



7. Member Institutions shall pay an annual subscription to the University for services listed in Ordinance 10.

***Member Institution***

15. The Collegiate Council will consider applications from institutions to become Member Institutions of the University against the approved strategic policy and criteria, and against any additional matters specified by the Board of Trustees, and make recommendations to the Board of Trustees on their admission or otherwise.
16. The Board of Trustees will consider the recommendations of the Collegiate Council and may admit as a Member Institution, an educational, academic or research institution provided that, in the opinion of the Board of Trustees, its admission is consistent with the agreed strategic policy and criteria for admission of institutions.
17. An institution shall be admitted as a Member Institution if two-thirds of the members present and voting at a meeting of the Board of Trustees vote in favour.

25. The Board of Trustees may decide to initiate proceedings for consideration of the withdrawal of Member Institution status from the Member Institution.
26. The Board of Trustees shall put the information on which the opinion to initiate proceedings was based to the Member Institution, not less than two calendar months before the meeting of the Collegiate Council at which withdrawal of Member Institution status will be considered.
27. If the Member Institution wishes to make representations, they must be received by the Vice-Chancellor not less than 10 clear working days before the meeting of the Collegiate Council.
