

## CP (Career Progression)

functions added to compulsory student registration and re-enrolment

**What is it?**

1. **Learning-focused**

2. **Useful experience**

**What are the core questions?**

1. student's self-reported

2. Useful experience gained (e.g. placements, volunteering and internships)

*not just those who are already engaged.*

**Tracking all students, not just those who are already engaged.**

- ✓ Inform strategic services
- ✓ Engagement
- ✓ Identification of 'at risk' groups
- ✓ Identifying specific employability needs of groups
- targeted marketing leading to
- Measurement for effectiveness of employability initiatives
- ✓ Assessing the impact of departmental and student engagement in employability
- ✓ Use with individual students in careers sessions and tutorials
- ✓ Raise student awareness of careers support options

3-year HEFCE funded pilot project to investigate the use of CP as a measure of learning

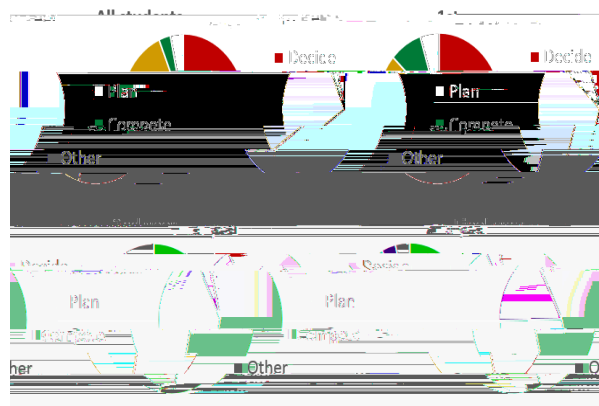
A 3-year HEFCE funded pilot project to investigate the use of CP as a measure of learning
