Located at our iconic Senate House, our School of Advanced Studies is the UK's national centre for the support and promotion of research in the humanities. We are also home

to Senate House Library, one of the UK's largest academic libraries for arts, humanities and social sciences, with over two million items in our collections.

In 1868, we were the first UK university to open education to women, and the University has pioneered distance learning since 1858. We count world leaders amongst our alumni, including Nelson Mandela, who studied with us as a distance education student when he was in prison awaiting trial.
