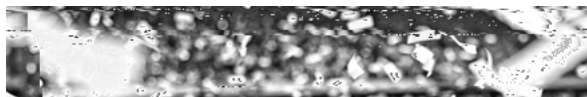
You will also focus on the creation of sustainable events and designing legacies to maximise the contribution made by the event.
