

Libraries

On the following pages we give details of libraries which have been, in the past, prepared to offer their facilities to University of London distance learning students. This information was correct at the time of publication. You should contact the libraries directly for information about access and opening hours, subject areas offered and any fees that might be payable (see also their websites).

If you are not able to buy all the textbooks and periodicals you need for your studies, or need a quiet place to study, you should do your best to join or get access to a good local library.

If there are no libraries listed in your country or region, we suggest that you contact your nearest British Council office to see if it has a library or can recommend any alternatives. You can use the VLE to ask other students which libraries they have found most useful. You could also ask universities or colleges near you if they allow students of other universities to use their libraries. Remember that some libraries may not have the space or the capacity to offer such a service.

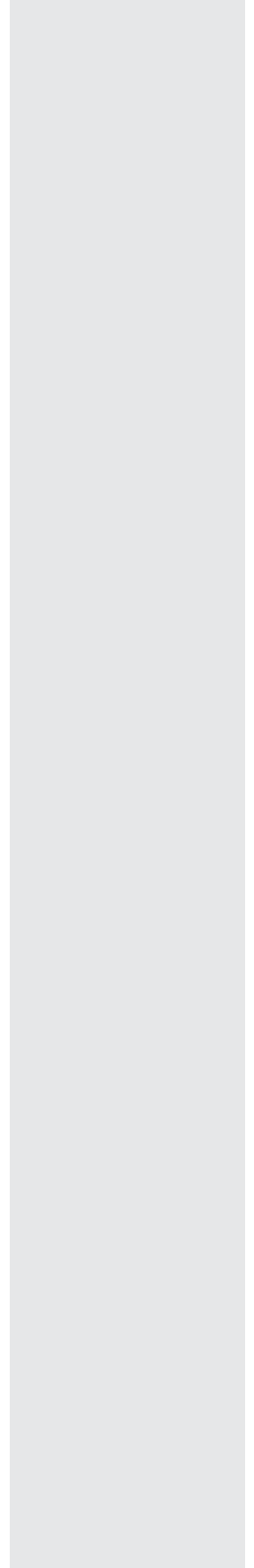

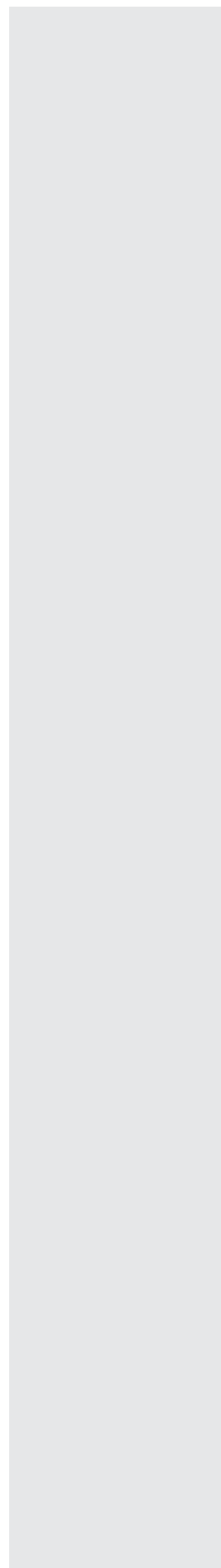
