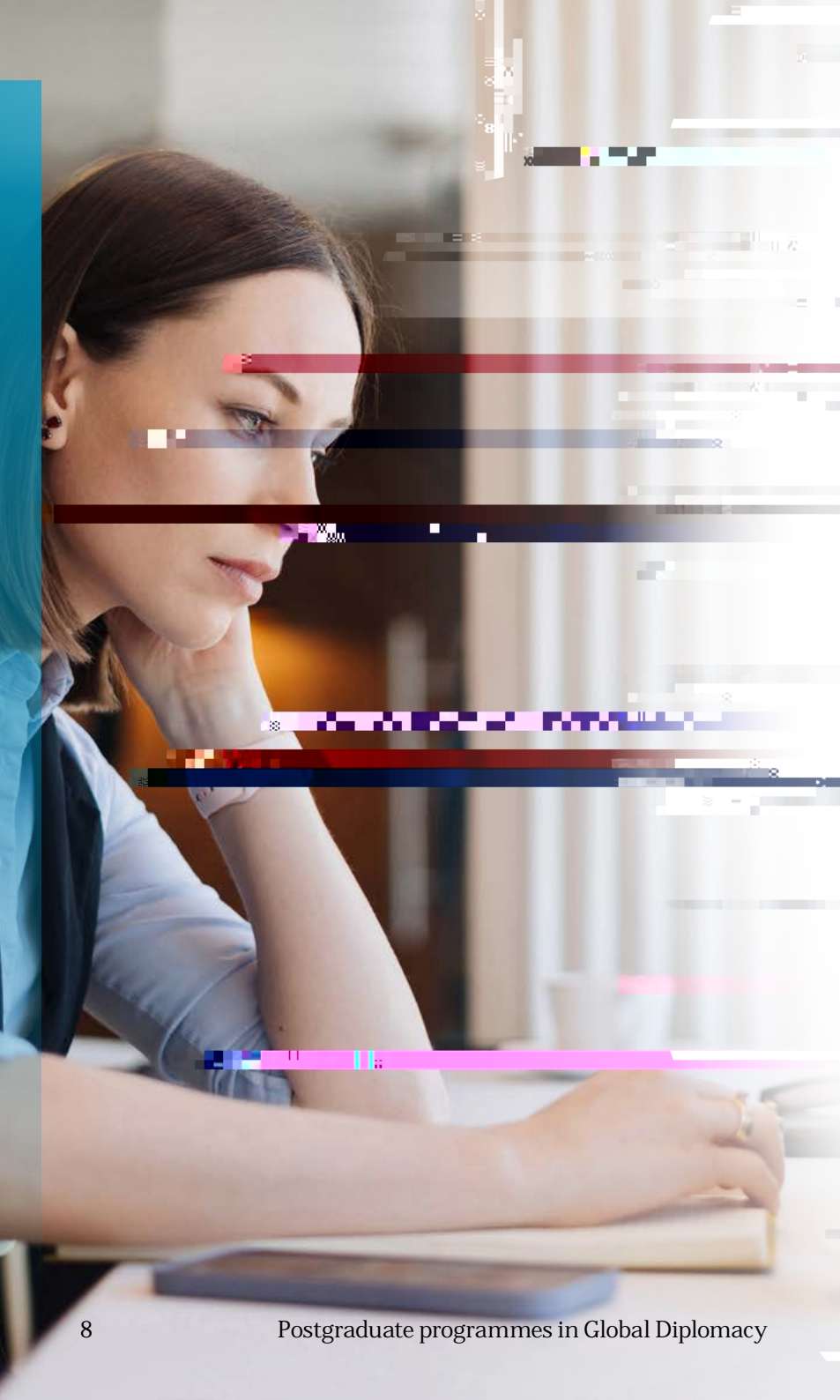

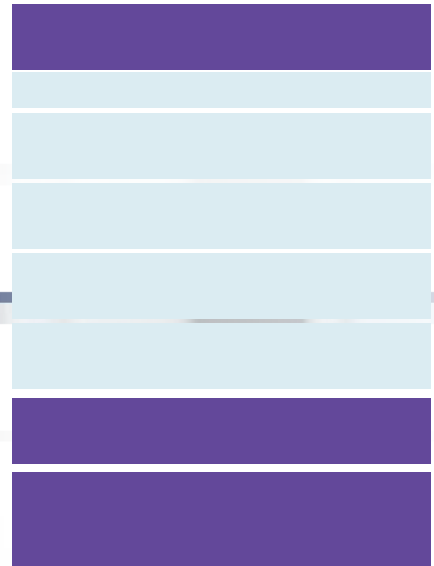

- relevant professional experience.

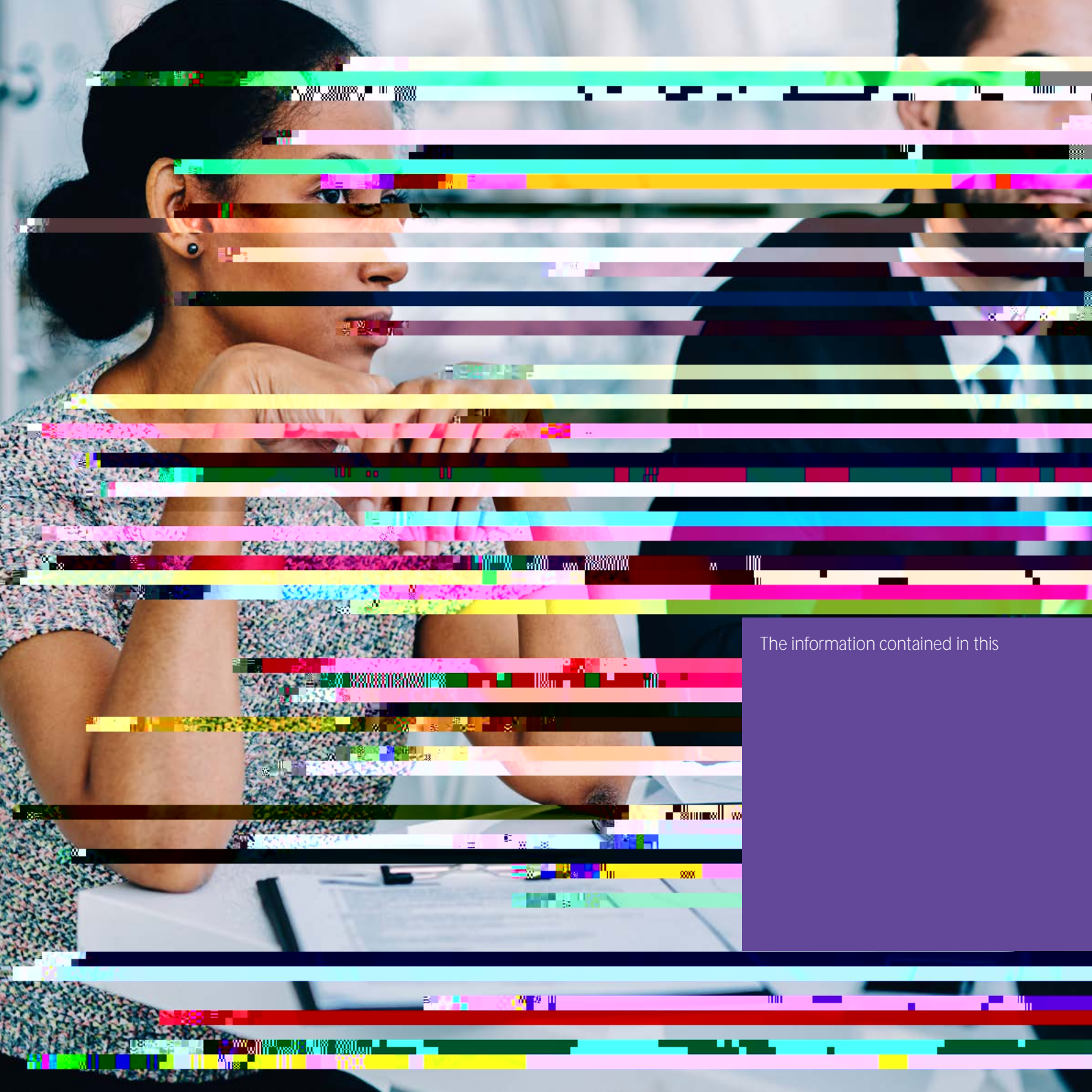
We will consider every application on its own merits.
