

# Entrance requirements and further information




For your application to be considered you will need the following:

- a minimum upper second-class honours degree (or equivalent) from an acceptable institution
- relevant professional experience.

We will consider every application on its own merits.

We accept quali cations from around the world. If you have an appropriate professional award rather than a degree, we will consider this on an individual basis.
